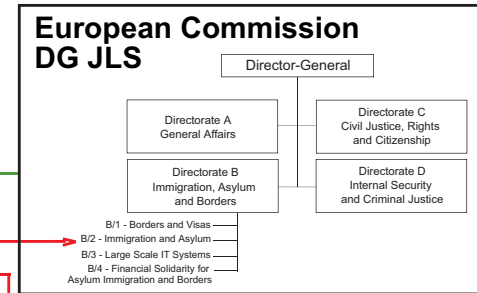
- "Supplemental agreement between the Europol Police Office and the United States of America on the exchange of personal data and related information", signed by the Representative of the United States of America to the European Union and the Director of Europol in Copenhagen on 20 December 2002



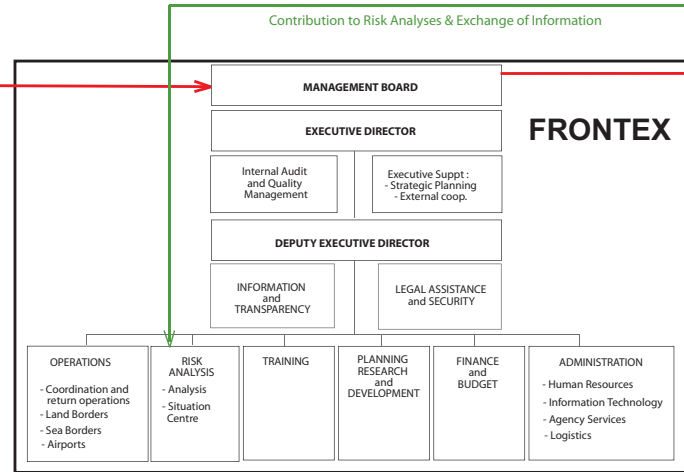

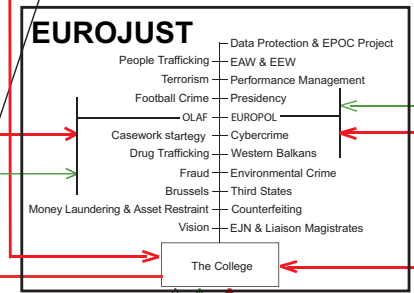
- Provision of Support for Joint Return Operations

- Provision of Training of National Border Guard Services

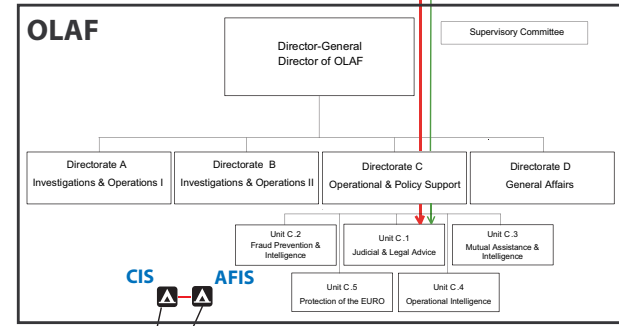

Since 2005: under the new team structure introduced at EUROJUST, a special team was formed dedicated to working with EUROPOL



C-SIS: consulted and fed by national authorities designated by the member states through the national SIS databases (N-SIS) - (6)

- FRONTEX is a community body (first pillar), established under Art. 62(2)(a) and 66 TEC, with legal personality (Council Regulation n°2007/2004 Art. 15).

- Commission proposes candidates for directorship of the Agency to the Management Board (Council Regulation n°2007/2004 Art. 20, Art. 26).

- Commission has two representatives on the Management Board (Council Regulation n°2007/2004 Art. 21).

- Commission allocates a budget to the agency taken out of its budgetary line (Council Regulation n°2007/2004 Art. 29).

- Commission is the reporting body, with regard the Agency's status as a Community body, and estimates the financial needs of the Agency before forwarding them to the budgetary authority (Council Regulation n°2007/2004 Art. 29).
